

TOP 10 REASONS TO CONDUCT ENVIRONMENTAL AUDITS AT YOUR FACILITY

REASON	COMMENTS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Past compliance problems have resulted in fines and/or penalties. 	A repeat offense will result in more trouble and stiffer fines
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Refinancing or new loans from banks require that environmental audits of key facilities be performed prior to loan approval. 	Banks and loan institutions want to limit their liabilities.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Environmental audits are required as part of the ISO 14000 Environmental Management System for the facility. 	Environmental audits are a key component for the ISO 14000 Measurement and Evaluation process.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Top management requires a greater understanding of the environmental compliance status of the facility. 	New compliance certification statements that are signed by top management as part of air permits and air emission reports are more comprehensive and carry more liability for those that sign them.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current staffing constraints cannot keep up with new regulations and training requirements. 	The “do more with less” concept has its limits.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New regulations are complex and require special expertise to fully understand. 	NSR, PSD, NSPS, NESHAP, SPCC, TRI; you need a dictionary of acronyms to get past page one of many regulations.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Company mergers and buyouts require audits of facilities to determine potential liability. 	Potential buyers want to limit their liabilities.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New equipment or processes have been added. 	New equipment and processes often bring new regulations and requirements.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Key people have left the company and no one knows what to do. 	Lack of proper record keeping is a major source of compliance problems.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Periodic audits are a good business practice. 	Just as regular medical checkups are essential to good personal health, periodic audits are essential to good business health.
